**F**or our Summer Exhibition this year, the 7th in the series, we have chosen the title "The Four Georges".

The stars of the show will be the fine examples of Cabinet making and Furnishing spanning nearly a century and a half, encompassing the reigns of the first four Kings George.

The exhibition, as usual, will be presented in glittering room sets, one for each of the four reigns in the period 1714 to 1830. In the first you will find the predominantly walnut George 1st period furniture with its restrained elements, a strong contrast to the mid-18th century mahogany pieces of George II's time.

The transition from the homes of the early 18th century, through the Palladian period to the early rococo will be apparent and continue through the reign of George III showing the influences of Robert Adam and the neo-classical.

Great changes in style and taste brought the flamboyancy of the Regency and "Prinny's" accession as George IVth, which will be the theme of the last room setting.

You will have a rare and splendid opportunity to examine, compare and acquire cabinets, bureaux, tables, chairs and mirrors from the different periods.
